



## Cardiff Metropolitan Cathedral Choir Adult Choral Scholarships and Lay Clerkships

The Cathedral Choir consists of:

- Choral scholars, including several from Cardiff University and the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama,
- Lay Clerks (professional soloists, and including singers in WNO), and
  - Cathedral Choristers (boys and girls aged 8 to 18 educated at the Choir-School St John's College).

**Repertoire** includes 8-part anthems and motets such as Palestrina Stabat Mater, Lotti Crucifixus, Gabrieli Jubilate Deo, Schütz Jauchzet Dem Herrn, Harris Faire is the Heaven, Britten Hymn to the Virgin, Wood Hail Gladdening Light, and the Rheinberger Mass for Double Choir, as well as divisi and multi-part repertoire such as Byrd Great Service, Byrd Haec Dies, Sing Joyfully, Mendelssohn Denn er hat seinen Engeln befohlen, Tallis Lamentations, Weelkes Hosanna to the Son of David, extracts from Rachmaninov Vespers, and contemporary repertoire.
