In recent years the choir has sung with a number of cathedral choirs in the UK and abroad, and with other ensembles such as the BBC National Orchestra of Wales on BBC Radio 3, the Chamber Strings of Melbourne (Australia), Philadelphia Boys Choir (US), and *Spem in alium* with the Tallis Scholars.
